Escuela's purpose is to instill the values of academic achievement, cultural pride and leadership in Latino children and youth. Escuela serves as a culturally competent learning environment and resource for parents, students and the community.

#### **MISSION**

The mission of Escuela Tlatelolco Centro de Estudios (Escuela) is:

- o to liberate the mind, heart, and spirit of students through cultural expression, moral courage and honorable behavior;
- o to empower students to become well educated, responsible, self-directed, critical and creative thinkers:
- o to challenge them to embrace their own history; to acknowledge their self-worth;
- o to develop a commitment to social justice; and to reinforce education as knowledge learned and shared.

#### 40 Years of Educational Excellence – Program Highlights

- <u>Círculo Montessori de Tlatelolco</u> a dual-language early childhood education Montessori program for 3 to 5 year olds.
- <u>Elementary Program</u> a dual-language Montessori program for 1<sup>st</sup> 6<sup>th</sup> grade and <u>Adolescent Academy</u> for 7<sup>th</sup> 9<sup>th</sup> grade.
- <u>Upper School</u> an experiential dual-language academic program for middle and high school students.
- <u>El Centro Cuepopan</u> an after school and summer arts program.

#### **Program Successes**

- Named one of Denver's Top Schools by <u>5280 Magazine</u>, September 2008
- 90% graduation rate since 1970
- Since 1971, 343 students that graduated, 67% completed undergraduate college degrees and 22% completed graduate degrees - 88% currently employed, and 25% own a business.
